

SLIDE PRESENTATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Your final produce will be a set of GOOGLE SLIDES with 4 total slides.

Slide 1: Title Slide

- Include the name of the presentation:
Artistic Annotations: Response and Analysis,
- And your name, school, grade

Slides 2-4: Art and annotations

- You will select THREE (3) different pieces of art from the categories shown in the folder, Painting, Sculpture, Dance, Photography. Select only one piece of art from the categories given.
- Each slide has one work of art and the annotation of that work of art. You may arrange those two items in your own creative design.
- Refer to Activity 2 folder for sample slide presentation to guide you as you prepare yours.

Preparing your slides:

- Once you have selected your art simply COPY and PASTE the work into a slide. Then create a TEXT BOX to insert your citation and written annotation.
- Works of art require a citation just as books and articles do. Below are the guidelines for creating a citation for a work of art:
 1. *Provide the artist's name,*
 2. *the title of the artwork in italics, and*
 3. *the date of composition. Finally,*
 4. *provide the name of the institution that houses the artwork*
 5. *the location of the institution (city or country)*

- The annotation you will write is a brief explanation of what you observe in the work of art as well as ideas you can pull from the work.
 - The annotation should be between 90-100+ words.
 - Use only **Times New Roman** font, **14 pt font size**.
 - Avoid First Person (I, me) and Second Person (You) voices
